Under the contract, the local company will manufacture filters to be used in electronic warfare products. Production of the filters will take place at Knowles Precision Devices’ manufacturing facility in Cazenovia over a 21-month period from August 2019 to April 2021. The company expects to create multiple immediate local job opportunities, including positions in engineering and manufacturing, in order to support the demands of the project.

It will require us to expand our operations and significantly increase the daily volume of product produced at the Cazenovia facility, which is why we’re looking to add to our team.”
